**Warren K. Winkler, B.A., L.L.B., L.L.M**  
**Chief Justice of Ontario**

Ontario Chief Justice, Warren K. Winkler is a man of distinction. Deeply respected as a judge and admired as a down to earth “people person” with a great sense of humor, Ontario Chief Justice, Warren K. Winkler is an avid jazz lover. Indeed, he has been an Honourary Chair of JPEC since its inception.

After spending his formative years in Pincher Creek, Alberta, he received his BA from the University of Manitoba and pursued his legal studies at Osgoode Hall Law School. Called to the Bar of Ontario in 1965, he practiced law and was a founding partner with Winkler, Filion and Wakely, where he became recognized as the pre-eminent expert in labour and employment law. Judge Winkler is a QC who holds three honorary doctorates and an LL.D.

In June 2007, he was appointed Chief Justice of Ontario, following 14 years as a trial judge of the Superior Court of Justice of Ontario. During that time, Chief Justice Winkler held a range of judicial administration portfolios, including Team Lead for the Long Trial List and for Class Proceedings, and Regional Senior Justice for Toronto.

His accomplishments are substantial. He has judicially mediated many large national and international disputes, including Air Canada Restructuring, Walkerton Tainted Water Trial, Ontario Hydro Power Workers, Native Residential Schools, Can-West/Shaw and Cable restructuring. He has written, co-authored and edited a broad selection of publications. Chief Justice Winkler has been an active educator and speaker at national and international events on a range of topics, including class actions, access to justice, alternative dispute resolution, labour relations, judicial mediation and civil justice reform. An avid outdoorsman, he is also the founding chair of the Long Point Waterfowl and Wetlands Research Fund and a Board Member of Bird Studies Canada.



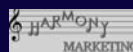
