THE AWARD

The Award of **\$2,500.00** is in recognition of superior jazz music compositional ability and performance by an ensemble of up to 10 musicians.

There will be four Awards of \$2,500.00 each, for one student from each of the four Ontario Jazz Colleges.

ELIGIBILITY

- The Applicant must be enrolled as a student (undergraduate or post graduate) in one of Ontario's Jazz Colleges.
- The Award is not open to previous Rochelle Koskie Jazz Student Scholarship Award recipients.

MAIN JUDGING CRITERIA

- Overall Sound
- Interpretation of Jazz Idiom
- Improvisation or Creativity
- Technique
- Dynamics

REQUIRED MATERIALS

- Completed Application form
- Written Score (PDF in Concert Pitch)
- Letter of Composition Intent or Objective
- Recording Transmission Option – MP3

SELECTION PROCESS

The Application will be judged by a panel of professionals involved in all aspects of Jazz music.

THE SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES (4)

The winners (one from each of the four Ontario Jazz Colleges) will be honoured at an awards ceremony at the next scheduled JPEC Concert.
